Good to see warmer weather after a somewhat long winter season. As the snow melts all of our to-do list items that didn't get done last year and through the winter are still there to haunt us... It does look like we have some progress to report on some of the items that have been on the list for some time.

The main upgrade/repair we have been talking about for years (it seems) is the work at the Starbuck CBC site. We decided not to wait to combine our work with other projects at the CBC site and have professional tower workers do the job right away. Work is scheduled for Thursday April 3rd. Lakehead Tower Erectors were available this week and are happy to do the work for us. Hopefully all goes well and we will have better VHF coverage at VE4MAN, and links into Winnipeg and Morris working again.

We have also been talking about upgrading the link at Gimli so the path between Winnipeg and the Gimli repeater site are more stable. We have an MSR-2000 UHF 30w repeater radio (used as the link) ready to install hopefully this weekend if all goes as planned. We hope this cures the link trouble we have had for quite some time.

The MRS executive is working on replacing many of the old Motorola Micor radios we have been using for link radios. The old Micors are operating well beyond their standard life expectancy and need to be replaced. The UHF MSR-2000 radios are a great replacement and require little to modify them for amateur radio band use. We are looking for more, so if anyone knows of some that are available please advise!

We are also hoping to install the VHF antenna at the Bruxelles site for the VE4MRS repeater soon. As soon as we get Starbuck out of the way we will be arranging with the riggers so work can go ahead as soon as the site is accessible.

Here's a quick rundown of our repeater status as it is right now:

VE4EMB, 147.36+ MHz, Hadashville

Repeater is working well. Link to Falcon Lake is very noisy and intermittent however. We are looking into resolving this problem by adding a pre-amp to the link receiver at EMB.

VE4MIL, 145.21- #42 Milner Ridge

Working well. Links to Winnipeg and Falcon Lake working properly

VE4GIM, 146.85-, #44 Gimli

Repeater is working well. Link is not working properly and we hope to have this looked soon. We have the link radio ready to go. Potential install date is Sunday April 6th.

VE4VJ, 443.500+, #45 Winnipeg

VE4WRS, 145.45-, Winnipeg, Autopatch, IRLP

VE4WPG, *147.39+,#45 Winnipeg*

Repeaters are working well. Construction downtown and more transmitters nearby our equipment are causing some interference and/or dead spots around the city. There is very little we can do about these problems other than re-locating the system; not an option right now, plus it would be most difficult to find a spot as good as it's current location.

VE4MAN, 146.61-, #46 Starbuck

Operating at reduced transmit power and receiver gain. There are problems with the antenna and filtering causing inconsistent operation. The new antenna should remedy much of this, and we are planning to upgrade the duplexer filter once the antenna issue is taken care of. Links 1 and 3 are not operational at this time. We hope to have this resolved very soon!

VE4CDN, 145.27-,#47 Morris

Operating fine. Link requires a radio upgrade, the Micor failed again before the link at Starbuck was available. We have crystals on order. Hope to have link working this summer.

We will also be installing a link to Winkler, possibly this winter. The Winkler (VE4TOM) repeater and Morris will be hot-linked. VE4TOM is owned and operated by Prairie Mobile Communications.

VE4PLP Link site

We replaced a power supply and repaired a link radio for this site this winter. It seems to be working well, the link to Brandon is working via link #2 at VE4MAN.

VE4MRS, 145.31- #48 Buydens Hill (Bruxelles)

Currently a link site between Brandon and Portage. We have brand new feedline ready to go and the antenna is already at the site. We need riggers to install this equipment for us, hopefully soon.

Pinetree Inter-tie (VE4FAL and east)

Working well, however the link to Kenora is not fully operational. The link does work when atmospheric conditions elevate RF propagation.

Brandon Link

VE4TED 146.73 MHz Brandon

Owned and operated by the Brandon Amateur Radio Club. This repeater is operational, but the link does not work at this time. We hope to have the links working between Brandon and Starbuck soon. See notes for PLP and MAN repeaters above.

Technical Report

Presented by VE4AJO

- VE4AJO explained that CBC requirements are for professional tower climber at Starbuck Tower. Expensive. Also require a professional climber for Bruxelles tower. Due to bad weather last spring, all tower climbers are far behind in their work.
- The link between VE4MAN and VE4WPG is down. We do not know if the problem is the antenna or the feedline. We hope to have the tower climber check that out, and possibly make repairs, or replacement when he installs the Comprod VHF folded dipole. Hopefully, before freeze up.
- The link between VE4MAN and Brandon is working
- VE4GIM to VE4WPG is intermittent.

- Someone installed a new tower and antenna on the Richardson Building, close to ours. This shades our signal on VE4WPG to the North. Recommend using VE4VJ if members have UHF radios. VE4VJ has excellent coverage in all directions.
- VE4CDN is working well
- VE4GWN asked if the Technical Committee could add an autodial feature to the phone patch. The autodial would connect to the Weather Office, especially during Canwarn situations. VE4AJO advised that the executive will investigate and get back to VE4GWN


